The camp was conducted with the objective of promoting voluntary blood donation and serving humanity. The initiative witnessed active participation from donors and community members.

At the conclusion of the programme, all donors were awarded certificates by the Blood Centre, Assam Medical College Hospital, Dibrugarh, in recognition of their valuable contribution.



### ***First Aid Training Programmes (FAT) – March 2026***

During March 2026, the Indian Red Cross Society, Assam State Branch conducted a series of First Aid Training (FAT) programmes in collaboration with various corporate and industrial establishments across Assam.

A total of four FAT programmes were successfully organized. In addition to these, an Individual FAT Programme (17–19 March 2026) trained 17 participants.

Overall, more than 100 participants were trained during the month in essential first aid techniques, CPR, bleeding control, fracture management, and emergency response.

The programmes emphasized workplace safety, emergency preparedness, and immediate response skills, enabling participants to effectively handle critical situations until professional medical help is available.

These training initiatives continue to play a vital role in building a safer and more prepared community, reinforcing the Red Cross mission of humanitarian service.
